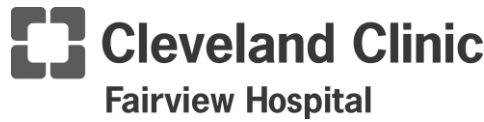

The West Park Cleveland Police and Fire Fighters Memorial Walkway was built to honor those brave safety officers who made the ultimate sacrifice. Located on Rocky River Drive, it begins at Edgecliff Avenue and runs north for one third of a mile along the Metroparks Canyon. It not only recognizes the tremendous sacrifice the fallen officers made, but offers their families and the community a gathering place to honor their memory.
